XXV. PAUL JOURNEYS TO ROME AS A PRISONER - PART 2 (MELITA TO ROME) (CHAPTER 28).

- A. Paul and companions treated with extreme kindness by barbarians at Melita (28:1-6).
 - 1. Paul miraculously survives poisonous snake bite.

- B. Paul heals the father of the chief man on the Island - Publius (28:7-10).
 - 1. Paul heals all sick on Island.

- C. Paul after three months sails for and lands at SYRACUSE (28:11-12).
 - 1. Paul remains three days.

- D. Paul arrives at RHEGIUM and PUTEOLI (28:13-14).
 - 1. Brethren ask Paul to remain at Puteoli for seven days.

- E. Paul meets brethren at the MARKET OF APPIUS and THE THREE TAVERNS (28:15-16).
 - 1. Paul thanks God and takes courage.

- F. Paul arrives in ROME (28:17-31).
 - 1. Must abide myself with the soldier guard.
 - 2. Paul explains his presence in Rome to the chief people of the Jews.
 - 3. Paul testifies of the Kingdom of God and Jesus on an appointed day before the Jews in his own place of lodging.
