

## 2 KINGS – LESSON SEVEN

- I. THE REIGNS OF AZARIAH (UZZIAH), JOTHAM AND AHAZ OVER JUDAH - THE REIGNS OF ZECHARIAH, SHALLUM, MENAHEM, PEKAHIAH AND PEKAH OVER ISRAEL (Chapters 15-16).**
- A. Reign of Azariah (Uzziah) over Judah (15:1-7).
- Character of reign:
    - Begins reign at age 16 – reigns 52 years.
    - Prosperous reign – success in war – building projects (cf. 2 Chronicles 26:1-15).
    - Did right before eyes of Lord – yet, people continued to offer sacrifices and incense in high places.
  - Struck with leprosy – separated the rest of life in separate house (cf. 2 Chron. 26:16-23).
- B. Reign of Zechariah over Israel (15:8-12).
- Character of reign:
    - Reigns six months.
    - Did evil in the sight of the Lord.
  - Shallum conspires and kills him.
  - Prophecy to Jehu fulfilled (cf. 2 Kings 10:30).
- C. Reign of Shallum over Israel (15:13-15).
- Character of reign - reigns one month.
  - Killed by Menahem in Samaria.
- D. Reign of Menahem over Israel (15:16-22).
- Character of reign:
    - Reigns ten years.
    - Did evil in the sight of the Lord .
  - Exact money from people to pay off Pul, the King of Assyria to cause him to turn back from invading the land of Israel.
- E. Reign of Pekahiah over Israel (15:23-26).
- Character of reign:
    - Reigns two years.
    - Did evil in the sight of the Lord.
  - Pekah, a captain, conspires against Pekahiah and kills him in Samaria in the palace of the King's house.
- F. Reign of Pekah over Israel (15:27-31)
- Character of reign:
    - Begins reign in the 52<sup>nd</sup>. Year of Azariah (Uzziah), King of Judah – reigns twenty years.
    - Did evil in the sight of the Lord .
  - Assyrian King – Tiglath-pileser comes to take captives from Israel away to Assyria.
  - Hoshea conspires and kills Pekah.
- G. Reign of Jotham over Judah (15:32-38).
- Character of reign:

- a. Begins reigning in second year of Pekah at the age of 25 – reigns sixteen years.
    - b. Did right in the sight of the Lord – yet high places not removed – people sacrificed and burnt incense in high places.
  - 2. Builds higher gate in the house of the Lord.
  - 3. God begins to send the Kings of Syria and Israel against Judah.
- H. Reign of Ahaz over Judah (16:1-20)
- 1. Character of reign (cf. 2 Chron. 28).
    - a. Begins reign in seventeenth year of Pekah at age 20 – reigns sixteen years in Jerusalem.
    - b. Did not that which is right in the sight of the Lord – did evil according to the abominations of the heathen.
  - 2. Seeks help of Tiglath-pileser against King of Syria.
  - 3. Has altar built in Jerusalem like the altar in Damascus- has sacrifices offered on new altar.

3. Azariah (Uzziah) reigned in Judah over the time in which \_\_\_\_\_ Kings reigned over Israel.
4. Against whom did Azariah (Uzziah) successfully war against by tearing down cities' walls?
5. What was Uzziah's attitude towards husbandry?
6. What military equipment did Uzziah put in place in the towers he built in the wilderness?
7. Why was King Azariah (Uzziah) struck with leprosy?

8. What major prophet began his prophetic work in the last days of King Azariah (Uzziah) ?
9. What was the character of the evil that Kings Zechariah, Menahem, Pekahiah and Pekah followed during their reigns over Israel?
10. What prophecy was fulfilled in the reign of Zechariah?
11. Shallum reigned how long in Samaria over Israel?  
How did his reign come to an end?
12. Why was Menahem so cruel to the inhabitants of Tiphshah?
13. What Assyrian ruler came up against Israel during Menahem's reign?
14. How did Menahem get his money to turn the Assyrian ruler away from the land of Israel?
15. How did Pekah bring an end to the dynasty of Menahem?
16. What Assyrian King came up against Israel during the reign of Pekah and carried some into captivity?
17. Who conspired against Pekah and killed him?
18. Describe the character of Jotham's reign over Judah.
19. What did Jehovah begin to do in the days of Jotham?
20. Whom did Jehovah send to Jotham to encourage him during this same time?
21. Describe the character of Ahaz's reign over Judah.
