

## 2 KINGS – LESSON TWELVE

- I. THE REIGNS OF JEHOAHAZ, JEHOIAKIM, JEHOIACHIN AND ZEDEKIAH OVER JUDAH – JUDAH TAKEN INTO BABYLONIAN CAPTIVITY (2 Kings 23:30b-25:30).**
- A. The reign of Jehoahaz (23:30b-33).
1. People of land put him on the throne – reigns three months.
  2. Jehoahaz's evil character (cf. Jeremiah 22:10-19).
  3. Jehoahaz is deposed by Pharaoh-Necoh.
- B. The reign of Jehoiakim (23:34-24:6a).
1. Jehoiakim is made King by Pharaoh-Necoh – reigns eleven years.
  2. The Captivity of Jehoahaz.
  3. Jehoiakim's evil character (cf. Jeremiah 26, 36).
  4. Jehoiakim is tributary to Pharaoh-Necoh.
  5. Jehoiakim is tributary to Nebuchadnezzar (cf. Dan. 1)
  6. Jehoiakim's rebellion.
  7. Jehoiakim's many adversaries.
  8. The death of Jehoikim (cf. Jeremiah 22:19, 36:30).
- C. The reign of Jehoiachin (24:6b-17).
1. Jehoiachin ascends to throne – reigns three months.
  2. Jehoiachin's evil character.
  3. Jehoiachin is taken captivity by Nebuchadnezzar.
  4. Great deportation of exiles to Babylon.
- D. The reign of Zedekiah (24:18-25:7).
1. Zedekiah made King by Nebuchadnezzar – reigns eleven
  2. Zedekiah' evil character.
  3. Zedeiah's rebellion
  4. The siege of Jerusalem
  5. Zedekiah taken captive by Nebuchadnezzar.
- E. Appendix to the history of Kingdom of Judah (25:8-30).
1. The overthrow and burning of Jerusalem.
  2. Remaining nobles slain.
  3. The treasures of the house of the Lord taken by Chaldeans.
  4. The last deportation to Babylon.
  5. Gedaliah is made Governor of Judah.
  6. The murder of Gedaliah and flight of the people (cf. Jeremiah 40-44).
  7. Jehoiachin is set at liberty.
